RULES :

1. Choice of Examination Centre outside Gwalior will be accepted only up to 25th September and after 25th September to 15th November, only Gwalior centre will be available.
2. If you are residing abroad and your ward is with you, he can take the test at the office of the local Indian Embassy there. On receipt of the letter of consent, we shall send the question papers to the Embassy and make a formal request to them to bear all expenses incurred by them in this connection, including postage and supervision charge etc.
3. Registration of a boy's name on the waiting list is NOT a guarantee for his admission. It will depend on his academic performance, interview and availability of a vacancy in the particular class to which the admission is sought.
4. A crossed Bank draft for Rs. 5,500/- issued in favour of PRINCIPAL, SCINDIA SCHOOL, payable at Gwalior towards the registration fee must accompany this form. This amount is neither refundable nor transferable under any circumstances. In case this form is downloaded from our website or photocopied a sum of Rs. 6,000/- is to be remitted.
5. Any dispute regarding Registration and Admission or any other matter related to the student would be subject to the jurisdiction of the Gwalior District Court only.
