

In his address, the Chief Guest recounted several instances from international cricket to emphasize upon the education which is derived through sportshumility and calm. Caps were distributed to the teams and the Chief Guest declared the competition open. A wonderful performance by the Brass Band of The Scindia School captivated the audience. Genesis Global made 102 runs which were achieved by Rajkumar College, Rajkot in 14.2 overs, defeating them by 9 wickets. The other match played during the morning session was between Daly College Indore and Yadavindra Public School in which Daly College won by 9 wickets. In the second session, Motilal Nehru Sports School, Rai and Manik Public School, Karnataka played against each other and MNSS Rai won the match by 142 runs.





On the third day of the tournament two matches were played. In the morning session, Yadavindra Public School played against Manik Public School, Karnataka.
